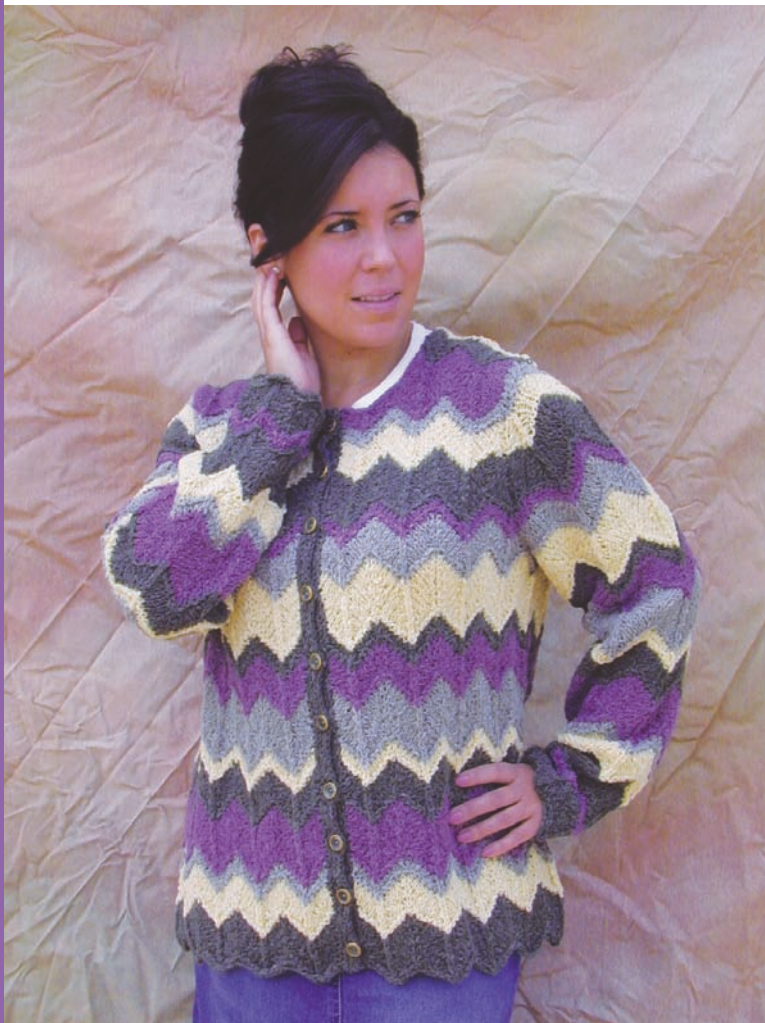

PATTERN NO. 1052

■ Intermediate

FINISHED SIZES

Finished Bust Measurements:

35.25	41.25	47.75	54 in.
89.5	105	121	137 cm

Finished Length:

21.5	24.5	25	26.25 in.
54.5	62	63.5	66.5 cm

MATERIALS

Knit One, Crochet Too® Yarn

Cotonade 50 gr/83yd hanks

4	4	5	6 skeins each
---	---	---	---------------

Spruce #590 (A),

Petal Yellow #411 (B),

Stone #547 (C)

Plum #753 (D)

Needles: US size 7 and 8 (4.5 and 5mm)

circular needles, *or size to obtain gauge*

Stitch markers

9	10	10	10 buttons
---	----	----	------------

GAUGE

In St st with larger needles, 18 sts and

24 rows = 4"/10cm

To check gauge in Chevron pat, work swatch as follows:

With larger needles

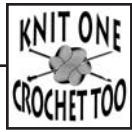
CO	33	39	45	51 sts.

Work Rows 1 and 2 of Chevron Pat for 22

rows. Swatch should measure

5.75	6.75	7.75	9 in. across x 4 in.

high from tip to valley.



Abbreviations

beg - begin(ning)	pat - pattern
BO - bind off	pm - place marker
CC - contrasting color	psso - pass slipped st over
cn - cable needle	pu - pick up
CO - cast on	rem - remain(ing)
cont- continue	rep - repeat
dec - decrease	RH - right hand
ea - each	rnd(s) - round(s)
eor - every other row	RS - right side
est - established	sep - separately
k - knit	ssk - slip, slip, knit
K2 tog - knit 2 sts together	st(s) - stitch(es)
LH - left-hand	St st - Stockinette st (k RS rows,
MC -- main color	p WS rows)
meas - measures	tog - together
ndl(s) - needle(s)	WS - wrong side
p - purl	WY - waste yarn

Special Techniques/Abbreviations

Kfb: Knit into front and back of st.

Ddec (double dec): Sl 2 sts tog knitwise, k1, pass 2 sl sts over.

Chevron Pat

multiple of 11 (13, 15, 17) sts; 2-row rep

Row 1: * Kfb, k3 (4, 5, 6), Ddec, k3 (4, 5, 6), kfb;
rep from * across.

Row 2: Purl.

Row 2 Alternate: * K5 (6, 7, 8), p1, k5 (6, 7, 8);
rep from * across.

Rep 1 and 2 (Row 2 Alternate where indicated) for Chevron pat.

Note: The sizing for this pattern is achieved by inc width of each Chevron rep for each size.

DIRECTIONS

BODY

Using larger needles and A, CO

198 234 270 306 sts.

Placing markers bet each Chevron, work Chevron pat in the following Stripe sequence, while alternating Colors A, B, C and D.

Rows 1 – 12: With A, work Row 1 and Row 2 Alternate once, then Rows 1 and 2, 5 times.

Rows 13 – 20: With B, work Row 1 and Row 2 Alternate once, then Rows 1 and 2, 3 times.

Rows 21 – 24: With C, work Row 1 and Row 2 Alternate once, then Rows 1 and 2, 1 time.

Rep Stripe sequence from Row 1 using D next; cont in this manner for Body.

Work even to

74 86 86 90 rows from beg.

ending after a Row 2 Alternate. Work measures

13.5 15.5 15.5 16.25 in. from beg.

Leveling Row (RS): Work in pat across 4 Chevrons;
* work across next Chevron omitting kfb's—

9 11 13 15 sts rem in Chevron*

Work in pat across next 8 Chevrons; rep bet ** once;
work to end.

Dividing Row (WS): Work across 4 Chevrons
[44 52, 60, 68 sts]

and place sts on holder for Left Front; BO next

9 11 13 15 sts for armhole;

work across 8 Chevrons

[88 104 120 136 sts]

and place sts on holder for Back; BO next

9 11 13 15 sts

for armhole; work on rem

44 52 60 68 sts for Right Front.

RIGHT FRONT

Armhole Shaping: Cont in est pat, dec 1 st at armhole edge every row until one complete Chevron as been dec,

taking care to maintain correct st count while working shaping

33 39 45 51 sts rem.

Work even until armhole measures

5 6 6.5 6.5 in.

above Dividing Row, ending with a WS row.

Leveling Row - Neck (RS): Work across first Chevron omitting kfb's, work to end

31 37 43 49 sts rem.

Next Row: Work across 2 Chevrons, BO rem

9 11 13 15 sts for Front neck—

22 26 30 34 sts rem.

Fasten off.

Re-attach yarn at beg of next RS row, and work even on rem 2 Chevrons until armhole meas

8 9 9.5 10 in.

above Dividing Row, ending with a WS row.

Leveling Row - Shoulder (RS): Work across both Chevrons omitting kfb's

18 22 26 30 sts rem for shoulder;

place rem sts on holder.

LEFT FRONT

Work as for Right Front, reversing armhole and neck shaping.

BACK

Work armhole shaping as for Fronts on each side

66 78 90 102 sts rem

Work even until armhole meas same as Fronts to

Leveling Row.

Leveling Row - Shoulder (RS): Work across first 2 Chevrons omitting kfb's, BO

22 26 30 34 center sts

purlwise for back of neck, work across rem 2 Chevrons omitting kfb's.

Join shoulders using 3-Needle Bind Off method or grafting (Kitchener) method.

SLEEVES

Using larger needles and A, CO

55 55 65 65 sts

Place markers bet each Chevron—five

11-st 11-st 13-st 13-st Chevrons across.

Note: Sleeve shaping is achieved by inc sts within each Chevron.

With A, following Chevron Pat over

11 11 13 13 sts [as for size S (S, M, M)]; work

Row 1 and Row 2 Alternate.

Cont with A, beg Stripe sequence on Row

5 15 13 15

Work colors and Stripe sequence as for Body for Sleeve. WHILE

AT THE SAME TIME, work even until piece meas

3 3 5 3 in.

from beg, ending after a RS row.

Inc Row (WS): Work kfb on each side of each Chevron across

13 13 15 15 sts for each Chevron

65 65 75 75 total sts.

Rep Inc Row every

5 5 5 4 in.

1 2 2 3 time(s)

75 85 95 105 total sts—five

15-st 17-st 19-st 21-st Chevron across.

Work even to same Color/Stripe row as Body to Leveling Row,

ending after a Row 2 Alternate

17 17.5 17.75 18 in. from beg.

Armhole and Cap Shaping (RS): Omitting kfb's in first and

last Chevron, BO

6 6 7 9 sts

at beg of next 2 rows—

59 69 77 83 sts rem.

Next Row (RS): Cont in est pat, omitting kfb's in first and last

Chevron.

Next Row: P2 tog, work to last 2 sts, p2 tog—

55 65 73 79 sts rem.

Rep last 2 rows until 3 Chevrons rem—

45 51 57 63 sts rem. Work

1 1 0 0 row even.

While working kfb's on center Chevron only, cont working Ddec

in all 3 Chevrons until

17 19 21 23 sts rem.

BO rem sts.

FINISHING

Buttonband: With RS facing, using smaller needles and A,

evenly pick and k

82 98 100 102 sts

along Left Front edge.

Knit 6 rows. With WS facing, BO all sts.

Buttonhole Band: Work as for Buttonband for 3 rows.

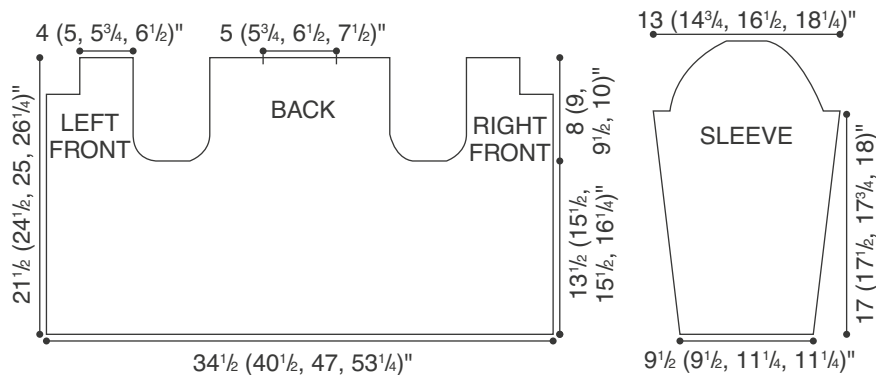
Next Row (RS): K6 (4, 6, 8) sts, [yo, k2 tog, k7 (8, 8, 8) sts] 8 (9,

9, 9) times, yo, k2 tog, k2.

Complete to match Buttonband. BO all sts.

Sew buttons opposite buttonholes.

Sew Sleeve seams. Set in Sleeves at armhole opening.
