## PATTERN NO. 1198

■ **Advanced Beginner**

## CUSTOM SIZES

Each Neck Warmer and/or Hat is worked to fit your size

## MATERIALS

**Knit One, Crochet Too® Yarn**

*Fleece* (100% polyester) 50gr/109yds

2 skeins for each Neck Warmer

*Jam* (100% nylon) 50gr/93yds

1 skein or less for each Neck Warmer

Stitch marker

**Needles:** US sizes 13 (9mm) 16 in. circular needle  
or size to obtain gauge

## GAUGE

In St st, with 2 strands Fleece held tog,

8 sts and 16 rows = 4 in./10cm

*To save time, take time to check gauge.*

## DETERMINING SIZES

To determine your finished size, measure your head.

For Version 3 and Hat on Version 2, multiply this size by 2 (your sts per inch)—this will give you the number of sts to CO. Work until 5.5 in. from beg for warmer.

For Version 2, add an additional 8 sts to Version 3 CO number. Work until 8.5 in from beg for warmer.

For Version 1, add an additional 15 sts to Version 3 CO number. Work until 8.5 in from beg.

## ADDITIONAL INSTRUCTIONS

For all warmer versions, CO required number of sts.

\* Join first rnd taking care not to twist sts. Purl 2 rnds.

Knit rem rnds in desired striped pat or introducing 1 strand of Jam in fabric. End with 2 purl rnds.

BO loosely, using larger-size needle if desired.

**HAT:** CO with 2 strands Jam held tog, work from \* on warmer, changing to Fleece and stripe pat as desired. Work for 8.5 in.

BO using 2 strands Jam held tog.

Sew top closed.
