

# TWEED LACE SCARF DUO

PATTERN NO. 1948 • Advanced Beginner

designed by Hélène Rush

**Knitted Scarf:** approx. 8 in. x 51 in.

**Crochet Scarf:** approx. 8 in. x 60 in.

## MATERIALS

### Knit One, Crochet Too® Yarn

*Elfin Tweed* (50-gr/208-yd, 60% Merino wool/  
20% baby llama/10% bamboo/10% donegal);  
2 hanks for knitted version Garnet #1278 OR  
4 hanks for crochet version Natural #1120

**Needles:** US size 4 (3.5 mm) straight knitting needles, OR

**Hook:** F/5 (3.75 mm) crochet hook, *or sizes to obtain gauges*

## GAUGE

**Knitted:** In Vine Lace, 29 sts = 4 in./10cm

**Crochet:** In Main Pat, 29 sts and 14 rows = 4 in./10cm

*To save time, take time to check gauge.*

## KNITTED VERSION

### STITCHES USED

**Seed St:** Set-Up Row: K1, \* p1, k1; rep from \* across.  
Subsequent Rows: Knit on purl sts, and purl on knit sts.

### Vine Lace

*multiple of 9 sts + 4; 4-row rep*

Rows 1 and 3 (WS): Purl.

Row 2: K3, \* yo, k2, ssk, k2 tog, k2, yo, k1; rep from \*,  
end k1.

Row 4: K2, \* yo, k2, ssk, k2 tog, k2, yo, k1; rep from \*,  
end k2.

Rep Rows 1–4 for Vine Lace.

### SPECIAL ABBREVIATION

**Ssk:** Insert needle in front of first st and in back of next  
st and k2 tog.

### FIRST END

CO 54 sts. Beg with WS facing, work Seed st on 7 sts, work  
Vine Lace on center 40 sts, work Seed st on 7 sts. Cont as  
est until 3.5 in. from beg, ending with a rep of Row 1 or 3.  
\* RS facing, purl 1 row, knit 1 row, purl 2 rows \*\*.  
Knit 1 row, purl 1 row \*\*\*. Place sts on holder.

### SECOND END

Work as for First End to \*\*\*. Beg with RS facing, knit 2  
rows, purl 1 row, knit 2 rows, purl 1 row. Beg with WS fac-  
ing, work Seed st on 7 sts, work Vine Lace on center 40  
sts, work Seed st on 7 sts. Cont as est until you have used  
most of the yarn, ending with a rep of Row 1 or 3, and  
reserving enough yarn to work 6 more rows (includes BO  
row). Work from \* to \*\* as for First End.  
Join live sts to sts on holder from First End using  
Kitchener stitch.

## CROCHET VERSION

### SPECIAL ABBREVIATION

**Bobble:** Holding back last lp of each on hook, work 3 dc, yo, draw through all 4 lps on  
hook to complete bobble.

### MAIN PAT

Ch 48.

Row 1: Sc in 8th ch from hook, \* ch 1, sk 1 ch, sc in next ch \*\*, ch 5, sk 3 ch, sc in next ch;  
rep from \* across, ending last rep at \*\*, ch 2, sk 1 ch, dc in last ch; turn.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in first dc, \* ch 3, work bobble in ch-1 sp bet 2 sc, ch 3 \*\*, sc in ch-5 sp;  
rep from \* across, ending last rep at \*\*, sc in ch-7 sp at end of row; turn.

Row 3: Ch 5, sc in ch-3 sp, \* ch 1, sk bobble, sc in next ch-3 sp \*\*, ch 5, sc in next ch-3 sp;  
rep from \* across, end last rep at \*\*, ch 2, dc in last sc; turn.

Row 4: Ch 1, sc in first dc, \* ch 3, work bobble in ch-1 sp bet 2 sc, ch 3 \*\*, sc in ch-5 sp; rep  
from \* across, ending last rep at \*\*, sc in ch-5 sp at end of row; turn.

Rep Rows 3 and 4 until scarf measures 60 in. long.

Do not break yarn at end of scarf.

### RUFFLE

#### First Side

Row 1: With last st on hook at end of last row, ch 1, work 1 sc in side of each row  
starting/ending with sc, and 2 sc in side of each row starting/ending with either dc or ch-5.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc), work 4 dc in first sc; \* ch 3, sk 2 sc, work 5 dc in next sc;  
rep from \* across, adjusting st placement as needed to end with 5-dc in last sc; turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in first dc, \* ch 6 \*\*, sc in ch-3 bet 5-dc group; rep from \* across,  
end at \*\*, sc in top of ch-3 at beg; turn.

Row 4: Ch 3 (counts as dc), work 4 dc in first ch-6 sp, then work 5 dc in each  
ch-6 sps across. Break yarn and fasten off.

#### Second Side

Attach yarn on opposite long edge of scarf and work as for First Side.

### Abbreviations

beg - beginning	est - established	sc - single crochet
bet - between	k - knit	sk - skip
BO - bind off	lp - loop	sp(s) - space(s)
ch - chain	p - purl	st(s) - stitch(es)
CO - cast on	pat - pattern	tog - together
cont- continue	rep - repeat	WS - wrong side
dc - double crochet	RS - right side	yo - yarn over
